Covid 19 Re-Opening Arrangements

- We look forward to re-opening and welcoming you all back to our classes, however we need to make sure we're doing this correctly and safely. This will be a slow and controlled process to make sure we get it right
- We will have all measures in place and we are taking all precautions necessary to re-open safely however it will be the parent/guardian responsibility to make sure their child is aware of covid-19 social distancing and hygiene practices and their choice to bring their child to our studios
- To facilitate everyone, we may have to introduce a rotation system where there will be a mix of in studio classes and online zoom classes
- Although we will have new hand sanitisers in our studio, each pupil entering our classes will need to have their own hand sanitiser with them
- It is the Parents/Guardian responsibility to ensure their child is fit and well enough to attend class, i.e checking temperature before attending the studio
- The Chester School of Dance teachers & assistants will have their temperature checked daily
- Unfortunately, if your child has a cold or flu like symptoms, they cannot attend class
- To reduce the amount of travel within our premises, we will get students to come to the venue ready for class, they will bring their bags/shoes with them and they will be left in their assigned place in the studio.
 - We would ask all pupils to use their toilet in their house before coming to our studio (our toilets will be available to use, but the less people using them the better).
- Parents will just drop pupils at the front door and we will bring them to the studio and likewise pupils will be collected from the front door.
- Please refrain from coming to our studios for 14 days after travelling from another country
- All payments and correspondence will now be online.
- Once schools confirm their plans, we will confirm our timetable for September then
